WHY IS THIS TOOLKIT IMPORTANT?

One in five Australians of working age have a disability, yet only 53% of people with disability participate in the workforce, compared to 84% of people without a disability*.

This statistic highlights a significant gap in employment opportunities.

The tourism and hospitality industry, which are vital to Western Australia's economy, face ongoing labour shortages, particularly in roles that require diverse skills and fresh perspectives.

Despite this, young people with disabilities are often underrepresented in these industries.

By engaging school leavers living with disabilities, employers can tap into an underutilised, highly capable workforce that can help bridge these gaps.

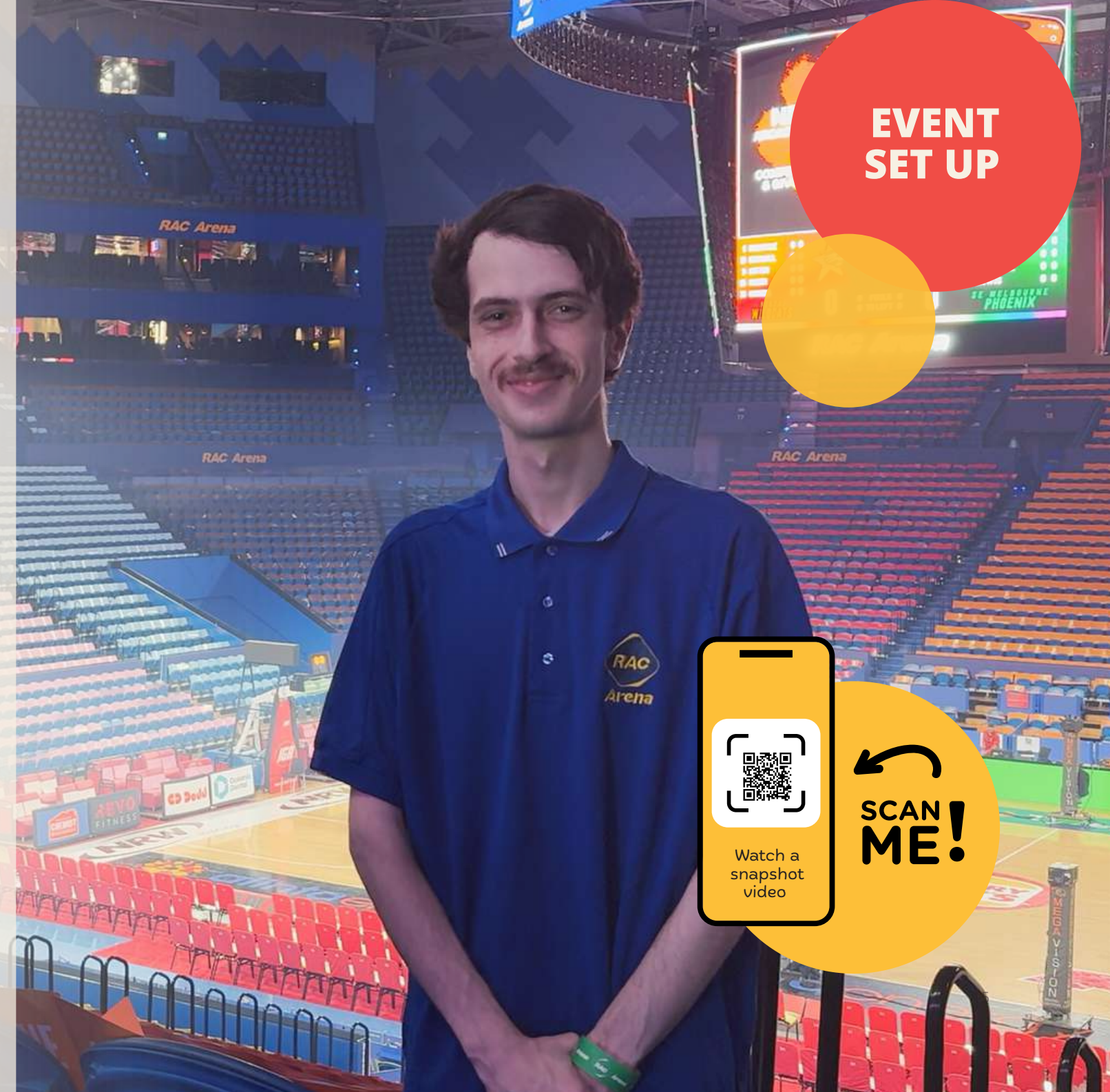
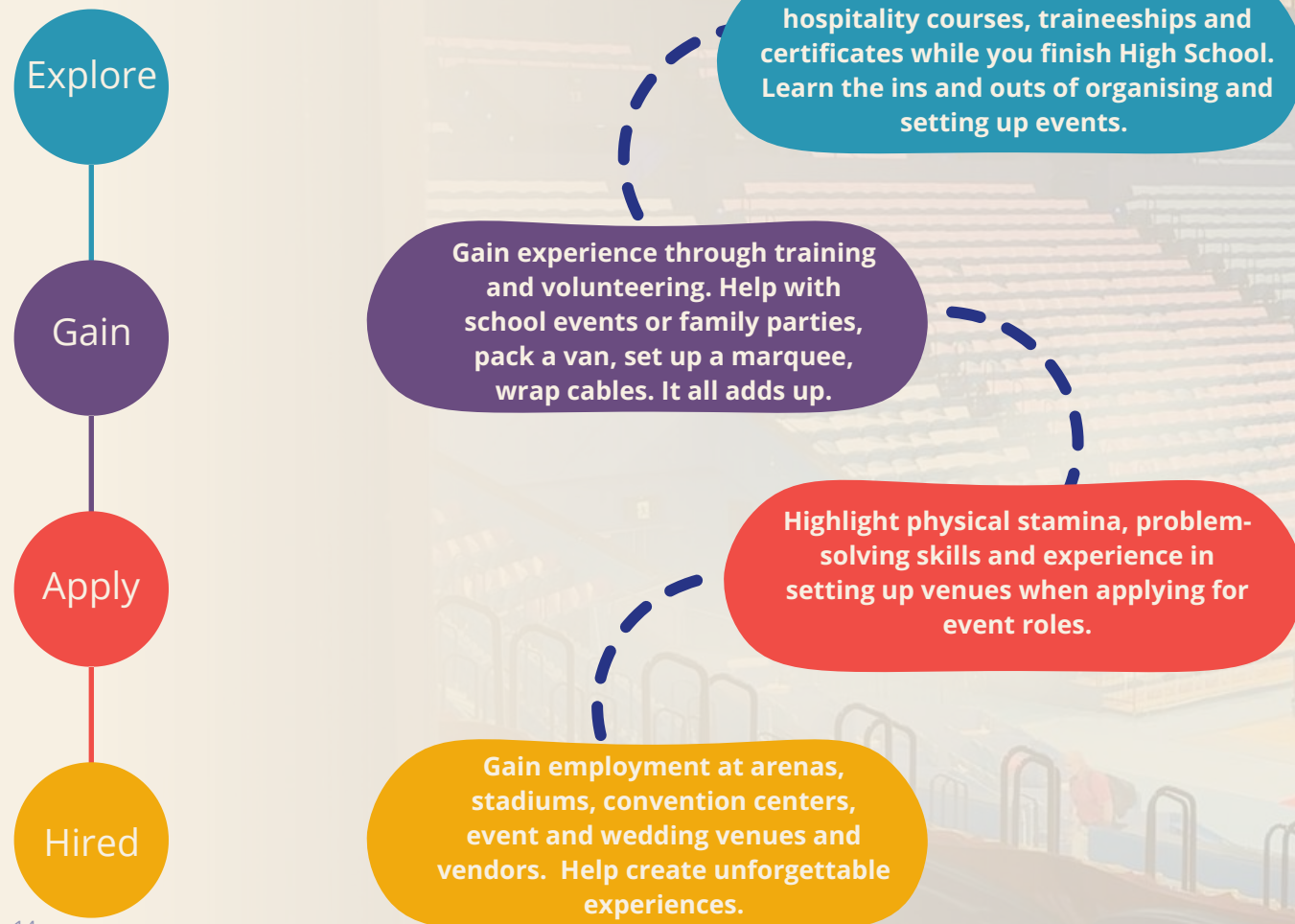

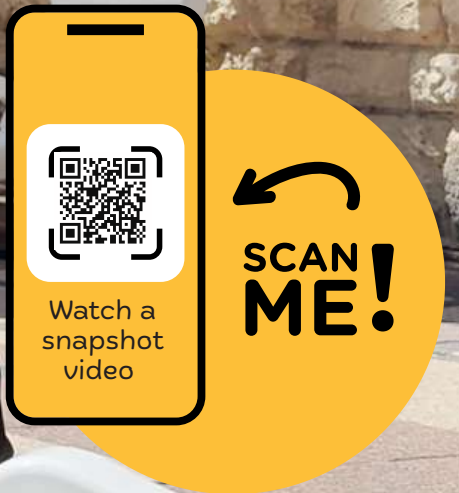

VISION To build disability confidence in the tourism and hospitality industry and become the leading sector employing people with disability in Western Australia.

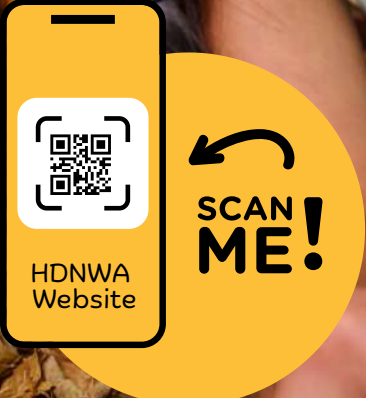
