


Career Profile





Overview

Bar attendants serve drinks, take orders, and interact with customers in bars, pubs, and clubs. They may also prepare cocktails, manage stock, and maintain cleanliness.

Requirments

Good customer service skills, a friendly attitude, and the ability to work in a fast-paced environment are important. Cash handling, confident with Point of Sale (POS) & knowledge of beverages are required along with ability to work weekends.

Training

A Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) certificate is required in Western Australia. Some employers provide additional on-the-job training.

Opporunities

Bar attendants can work in hotels, restaurants, cruise ships, and entertainment venues, with pathways to bar management or hospitality leadership.
